# Embark on a journey to Santa Fe, where history, art, and nature converge!

In Santa Fe, New Mexico, adobe architecture and vibrant plazas paint a rich cultural canvas. Amidst spicy aromas and Native American crafts, exploring the museums and the mountainous landscapes – including visits to Bandelier National Park and Taos Pueblo – is captivating. Interacting with indigenous people enriches the experience, creating cherished memories of this enchanting journey into the heart of Southwestern charm.



### Day One - Sunday - June 9th - Travel to Santa Fe, New Mexico

Arrive in Santa Fe to begin your adventure. You will be greeted at the airport and transported to your home-away-from-home for the next five nights, <u>Old Santa Fe Inn</u>. Once everyone arrives we'll celebrate our adventure with a no-host meet and greet on the hotel patio! Since we are arriving at various times, dinner will be on your own. There are several dining options within walking distance.

### Day Two - Monday - June 10th - Bandelier National Monument, Valles Caldera, Ohkay Owingeh Pueblo

Today, we'll explore Bandelier National Monument- the park offers a unique blend of natural beauty and archaeological wonders with a rich cultural history. After a picnic lunch, we'll visit the Valles Caldera, remnants of a volcanic explosion over a million years ago. The day concludes with a cooking class and welcome dinner hosted by Norma, a native Puebloan from Ohkay Owingeh pueblo.





### Day Three – Tuesday – June 11th – Santa Fe

Today, explore Santa Fe with a morning walking tour covering history, culture, and art. Afterward, enjoy free time for self-guided exploration. Lunch and dinner are at your discretion, with plenty of restaurant suggestions. The hotel's proximity allows for a quick siesta before further exploration.

## Day Four – Wednesday – June 12th – Abiquiu, Ghost Ranch, Santa Fe

A half-day of exploring is ahead: more of the southwest and getting up-close and personal with more gorgeous New Mexico scenery! We'll visit the town that Georgia O'Keeffe called home in the fall & winter – Abiquiu. Then on to famed Ghost Ranch – one of O'Keeffe's famous muses. It's a gourmet picnic for lunch, then back to Santa Fe to relax at the hotel or head into town. Dinner will be on your own, with dining options nearby.





## Day Five – Thursday – June 13th – Taos, Chimayo

We'll head to Taos, but first a trip to Chimayo, exploring historic churches with healing dirt (that's what the locals say)! In Taos, enjoy a walking tour, visit the UNESCO World Heritage site, Taos Pueblo, and have free time for lunch and exploration. Conclude the day with a special Farewell Dinner at Rancho de Chimayo, a historic 19th-century hacienda known for award-winning food, celebrating our adventure together.

## Day Six – Friday – June 14th – Depart from Santa Fe

We'll enjoy one last breakfast, then depart for our return to our "regular" lives and say farewell to beautiful Santa Fe and our special time together.

#### DATES:

5 night package: June 9-14, 2024

#### Cost:

5 night package: \$2,125 per person double occupancy; \$2,725 single occupancy

Unless otherwise noted, all participants on a Women on the Go trip must be at least 18 years of age at time of travel.

#### Payment Schedule:

Space is limited. Reservations will be made on a first-come, first-served basis.

- Deposit: \$750 per person due at time of registration.
- Final payment: Balance due April 10, 2024. Your balance will be charged to the credit card on file unless we are notified that you wish to use a different form of payment.

#### Cancellation:

Penalties vary depending on the date of cancellation:

- From date of booking to 61 days (April 9, 2024) prior to departure: Full refund minus \$250 cancellation fee, per person.
- From 60-31 days (April 10, 2024 May 9, 2024) prior to departure: Full refund minus \$1000 cancellation fee, per person.\*
- 30 days (May 10, 2024) prior to departure or less: 100% cancellation fee will apply\*

\* We will do all possible to resell your space should you cancel. If we are successful, we will refund you in full, less \$350 per person

#### Air Transportation:

You may make your own flight arrangements or we can assist with a \$50 per person service fee (waived for Women on the Go/WOW! Travel Club alumni). We cannot book mileage tickets or upgrades, which must be done directly with the carrier. If you would like us to assist, contact Howard Wise (<u>howard@wowtravelclub.com</u> or 818-444-2710). It is the responsibility of the traveler to provide the legal name as on the passport. Carriers may deny boarding if name on ticket does not EXACTLY match name on passport or drivers license.

#### Supplemental Travel Insurance for Trip Cancellation / Interruption:

Your package includes basic trip insurance:

- Emergency Medical Expenses
- Emergency Medical Evacuation and Return of Remains
- Accidental Death & Dismemberment
- Political Evacuation/Repatriation
- Natural Disaster Evacuation/Repatriation

Additional trip cancellation insurance is available for purchase to cover financial penalties if you need to cancel your trip. Travelers may insure all prepaid and nonrefundable payments against cancellation and interruption due to covered reasons. Note that fear of travel is not covered under these policies. Certain plans include coverage for Pre-Existing Medical conditions, financial default, "Cancel for Work Reasons" and "Cancellation for Any Reason." Coverage varies by product. **Please note that most insurance companies require you to purchase insurance within 14 days of the initial deposit date in order to be covered for pre-existing conditions.**

#### MedJet Assist – Air Medical Travel Protection Membership

MedJet Assist provides and pays for hospital-to-hospital medical transfer of a member if injury or illness occur during domestic or international travel, more than 150 miles from home. Unlike most travel insurance, a MedJet Assist member is transferred to their home hospital of choice, regardless of medical necessity. There are no "acceptable facility" clauses, no claim forms, no cost caps and no surprise bills after the transport. COVID-19 is covered (with some restrictions)
